You are not only supporting the work of Builders Without Borders of Texas. The pumpkins started life about 100 days ago on a farm on the Navajo Indian Reservation in Farmington, NM. Great care was taken in the planting, growing and harvest to ensure that you will purchase a quality pumpkin with a long shelf life. Nearly 100% of the farm workforce is Native American. The patch believes it is very important to use domestic labor, as the unemployment rate in the region is over 40%. This project and others like it create roughly 25 full-time jobs and 550 seasonal jobs for Native Americans.

The pumpkins are a non-GMO product. After ripening, the pumpkins are hand-loaded onto a truck and travel all the way to the pumpkin patch of Builders Without Borders of Texas DBA Blue Monkey Resale Gift Shop to help raise money for the work they do to provide help to people in need.
